



Fort Worth Transportation Authority (FWTA) is a regional transportation authority of the State of Texas. It provides public transportation to meet the mobility needs in Tarrant County and for connections with the North Central Texas region. FWTA annually provides more than 10 million passenger trips annually on buses, vanpools and the Trinity Railway Express (TRE), which the FWTA jointly owns and operates with Dallas Area Rapid Transit (DART). FWTA has started construction on TEXRail, a new commuter railroad from downtown Fort Worth to DFW Airport's Terminal B, scheduled to begin revenue service in late 2018. FWTA is governed by an 11-member board of directors which consists of eight Fort Worth City Council appointments and three by the Tarrant County Commissioners Court.
